Opportunity to tender

There is now an opportunity for a provider or partnership of providers to tender for pilot work developing outreach and personalised support packages for rough sleepers.

Outcomes

At the end of the pilot we want to be in a position to make a judgement about future investment and to do that we need to achieve the outcomes stated below.

- We have tested out personalised engagement and support responses with entrenched rough sleepers and enabled them to make the move into settled and sustainable accommodation.
- We have enabled up to 25 entrenched or excluded and vulnerable rough sleepers to move into settled and sustainable accommodation that they have been able to maintain for at least 3 months
- We have tested out new approaches across the areas involved that improve access to services and accommodation for people coming on to the streets for the first time.
- The learning and intelligence that is gathered during the pilot is used to contribute to systemic and strategic changes in provision for rough sleepers.

The areas covered by the pilot potentially includes:

- Black Country
- Birmingham
- Coventry
- Solihull
- Warwickshire
